Background:

Freese and Nichols, Inc. is currently at 60% design completion on Engineering Project EN2303 - Sheridan Rd. Reconstruction. The project includes pavement rehabilitation or reconstruction of approximately 1.5 miles of roadway section along S. Sheridan Rd. from ½ mile south of Bishop Rd. to Lee Blvd. Design fees for Freese and Nichols, Inc. have been encumbered through Project EN2303 in the Munis system in the amount of \$1,042,000. Construction costs are currently estimated at approximately \$14,600,000. Determination for construction funding is needed as well as prioritization of the project in the proposed schedule of upcoming city construction projects.
