"Official action can be taken only on items which appear on the agenda. The Council may adopt, approve, ratify, deny, defer, recommend, or continue any agenda item. The Council may also propose and enact floor amendments to any matter presented before them. When more information is needed to act on an item, the Council may refer the matter to the City Manager or the City Attorney. The Council may also refer items to standing committees of the Council or a board, commission, or authority for additional study. Under certain circumstances, items are deferred to a specific later date or stricken from the agenda entirely."

Business Items

1. Consider directing staff to coordinate with WSB to prepare engineering cost estimates and evaluate the feasibility of bundling bridge projects for the remaining bridges identified under Project B of the 2023 General Obligation Bond Program.
2. Administer the Oath of Office to the newly appointed Chief of Police, Craig Akard
3. Consider waiving the rules of Council Policy 1-06, Section 5-E, to allow reconsideration within a six-month timeframe. If approved, reconsider a request for a temporary stay of demolition on a dangerous and dilapidated structure located at 2211 NW Baltimore Avenue and take action as deemed necessary.

Executive Session

4. Pursuant to Section 307C.11, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, consider convening in executive session for the purpose of conferring on matters pertaining to economic development, including the transfer of property, financing, or the creation of a proposal to entice a business to locate within their jurisdiction, the public disclosure of which would violate the confidentiality of prospective business entities, and if necessary, take appropriate action in open session.
