Consider a request from Councilmember Hooton for the installation of traffic calming measures in the form of speed cushions on NW Ozmun between NW 52nd and NW 49th and consider staff's recommendation of speed limit signs instead based on the results on a traffic study, making a recommendation to council on any action to take.
3. Consider a request from Councilmember Hampton for the installation of traffic calming measures in the form of a speed table on NW Arlington between NW Sheridan and NW Morford and consider staff's recommendation of no action based on the results on a traffic study, making a recommendation to council on any action to take.
4. Consider a request from Councilmember Williams for the installation of traffic calming measures in the form of a speed table on SW Rolling Hills SW Sunflower and SW 40th and consider staff's recommendation of no action based on the results on a traffic study, making a recommendation to council on any action to take.
5. Consider a request from Councilmember Dimery for the installation of traffic calming measures in the form of a speed table on SE Aberdeen and consider staff's recommendation of no action based on the results on a traffic study,

Consider a request from Councilmember Epps for the installation of traffic calming measures in the form of a speed table and decorative crosswalks on NW Persing and consider staff's recommendation of no action based on the results on a traffic study, making a recommendation to council on any action to take.
8. Consider a request from Councilman Weger to install speed humps at or near 1136 NW 75th St and make a recommendation to Council on any actions to take.

9. Consider providing direction to staff to coordinate with WSB on the preparation of a task order for construction management design services for the 11 Bridges Project and take action as deemed necessary.
10. Receive a proposed task order from WSB for the SW 38th Street Project (Lee Boulevard to Bishop Road) and make a recommendation to City Council or direct staff as deemed necessary.
11. Discuss the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant awarded to the City of Lawton and provide direction to staff as deemed necessary.
12. Discuss the potential expansion of the 107 in 27 Program to include an additional 40 streets.
13. Receive a report on the demolition of bridge NBI-24123 located in the alley between SW I Avenue and SW J Avenue, between SW 8th street and SW 9th street.
14. Consider a request from Councilwoman Williams to install a "children at play" sign on SW 54th street, and make a recommendation to council on actions to take.
15. Discuss the placement of "No Engine Compression Brake (Jake Brake)" signs on Rogers Lane and make a recommendation to City Council as deemed necessary.
16. Consider a request from Councilmember Williams to install "No Thru Traffic" and "Dead End" signs at 6410 SW Heritage Road, and make a recommendation to council.

17. Consider a citizen request for the installation of new guardrails on SW Lee Boulevard over Goodyear Boulevard and make a recommendation to council to approve awarding the project to Action Safety for the installation of the guardrails.
18. Consider a request from staff, via citizen, to reduce the speed limit on sw 67th street to 30 MPH, in order to reduce damage and wear and tear on the roadway, and make a recommendation to council.
19. Consider a request from Councilwoman Williams on roadway maintenance and repair options for SW 67th street between Bishop and Coombs.
20. Consider a request from Councilmember Brown for the installation and modification of pedestrian crossing infrastructure, the changing of timing signals at 38th street and Meadowbrook, and making a recommendation to council on any action to take.
