1. Consider a request from Councilman Weger, received through a citizen, regarding the installation of a "Stop" sign on the private road leading to Chick-fil-A off 82nd Street, and provide a recommendation to Council regarding appropriate action. Planning has not yet assigned a name to this private road abutting 82nd Street.
2. Consider a request from Councilman Weger, received through a citizen, regarding the installation of "Stop signs" at the two drives off of SE Flower Mound Road going in and out of the Stone Ridge Apartments located at 3011 E Gore Boulevard.
3. Consider a request from Councilman Weger, received through a citizen, to install speed limit signage at or near 6704 NW Graysons Mountain Drive in response to the initial citizen request for the installation of speed tables.
4. Consider a request from Councilman Weger for increased enforcement in the vicinity of 1136 NW 75th Street in response to the findings of a speed study that was conducted on June 17, 2026 in the area.
