Hold a public hearing and consider amending Sections 18-12-2-1232 and 18-12-3-1243, Chapter 18, Lawton City Code, adding medical marijuana dispensary facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use and Commercial Central Districts, adding medical marijuana research facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use District, and excluding medical marijuana growing and medical marijuana processing facilities in the Mixed Use and Commercial Central Districts of the Downtown Lawton Overlay District.

Consider approving a resolution finding Amendment No. 2 to the Downtown I Urban Renewal Plan adding medical marijuana dispensary facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use, Commercial Central, and Commercial-Light Industrial Districts, adding medical marijuana research facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use and Commercial-Light Industrial Districts, and adding medical marijuana growing and medical marijuana processing facilities as permitted uses in the Commercial-Light Industrial District to be in conformance with the 2030 Land Use Plan for the City of Lawton.

Consider approving a resolution finding Amendment No. 3 to the D-6 Urban Renewal Plan adding medical marijuana dispensary facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use and Commercial Central Districts and adding medical marijuana research facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use District to be in conformance with the 2030 Land Use Plan for the City of Lawton.
6. Consider approving a resolution finding Amendment No. 1 to the Civic Center Urban Renewal Plan adding medical marijuana dispensary and medical marijuana research facilities as permitted uses in the Mixed Use District to be in conformance with the 2030 Land Use Plan for the City of Lawton.
