2-3-1-300 - Recognition and attendance at meetings.

- A. The mayor and city council recognize and appreciate the importance of involving citizens in the city government. To that end, unless provided otherwise in this code, the mayor appoints, and the city council confirms, individuals in the community to boards and commissions to advise the mayor and city council on certain matters affecting the community.
- B. Any appointed member of a city board, commission or advisory body who has three (3) unexcused absences from consecutive regular meetings shall automatically cease to hold such appointed office, and the office shall therefore immediately be declared vacant. Such vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the mayor subject to confirmation by the council. If the ordinance or resolution creating the board, commission or advisory body establishes an appointment procedure for initial and successor members, that procedure shall apply in this instance. For purposes of this paragraph "unexcused absence" shall mean an absence from a meeting that was not excused by the chairperson of the applicable board, commission or advisory body in advance of the beginning of the meeting.
- C. Unless enacted by ordinance or otherwise specified in an enabling document or action of the city council, boards, commissions, and committees appointed by the city council shall automatically cease to exist after the board, commission or committee submits its final report to the city council or one year after the creation of such board, committee or commission.
- D. Members appointed to boards, commissions or committees must be actual residents within the corporate limits of the city or Fort Sill at the time of appointment and during the term of office unless provided otherwise by state law, ordinance, resolution or action of the city council.
