BUSINESS ITEMS

1. Review and discuss a new Transportation Activity Management Program Policy for potential recommendation of adoption to the City Council, and take action as deemed necessary.
2. Review and discuss changes to the Traffic Calming Policy (Council Policy 10-05), and take action as deemed necessary.
3. Discuss the allocation of remaining FY25 funds for the Streets and Bridges Committee, including potential projects such as road segments and parking lots. Specific locations for consideration may include 38th Street (between Gore and Lee), NE 25th Street, the Library Parking Lot, Elmer Thomas Aquatics Center Parking Lot, and the Community Theatre Parking Lot and take action as deemed necessary.
4. Discuss potential amendments to the Streets and Bridges Committee bylaws, including the integration of Traffic Commission responsibilities (pending council approval) and any additional duties related to development and building, as discussed in the previous council meeting and take action as deemed necessary.
5. Review and discuss the “105 in ‘25” pavement rehabilitation segment list, and take action as deemed necessary.
6. Discuss the potential permanent closure and demolition of bridge M42-5 at in the alley between SW I Avenue & SW J Avenue, and between SW 8th Street & SW 9th Street and take action as deemed necessary.

7. Consider a proposal and direct staff to add the Sheridan Street Bridge (Structure 099940000000000) crossing Numu Creek at bridges Park as a candidate for the Bridge Investment Fund planning grant in FY25/26.
8. Consider whether to allocate funds from the FY25/26 Streets and Bridges Committee funding to pay for a matching portion of the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) planning grant and consider approval for staff to request to the City Council to apply for said grant.
9. Discuss going out for bid for the mill and overlay project on 38th Street, from Gore to Lee, and take any necessary action.
