3. Consider a request of exemption from City Code 21-6-604 (permanent markers and monuments) for the intersection of NW Mimosa Lane and NW Rogers Lane.
4. Consider implementation of traffic control and calming devices in the form of porkchops at the intersection of Cache and NW 23rd, both north and south sides of the intersection.
5. Consider a request to add a section to Lawton City Code, 2015 pertaining to streetlight requirements.
6. Discuss the problem of citizens running red lights and explore options to help with this issue.
7. Consider a request for a speed table at Hugh Bish School in Ward 1 and take action as deemed necessary.
8. Consider the recommendation for the future reconstruction of SW 44<sup>th</sup> Steet between SW Wolf Street and SW Wendy Drive.
9. Consider approving a contract supplement in the value of \$207,871 to WSB consulting for work requested by the committee, using committee designated funds.

10. Consider a citizen's request to add a directional sign at SW 38<sup>th</sup> and SW 27<sup>th</sup> and Dr. Elsie Hamm Dr., directing the public to the Senior Center for Creative Living.
11. Discuss the 11<sup>th</sup> Street bridges, as well as other miscellaneous bridges and take action as deemed necessary.
12. Discuss the installation of speed bumps and take action as deemed necessary.
13. Review and discuss the "105 Roads in 2025" initiative and take any action deemed necessary.
14. Discuss the current progress and review the timeline for the 38<sup>th</sup> street project.
