2. Minutes

A. Approval of minutes of July 3rd, 2012
Motion by Bothell with a second by Hadley to approve the minutes.

3. New Business –

A. Robert Kizarr - 8/1/12
Mr. Kizarr was not present. Chief Hadley said this happened when they were on an EMR call at 36th & Arlington, by the hospital. Chief Hadley showed a map of the area. They stopped, got out and went in the house and one of the guys came out and the truck was gone. They discovered the truck down the street at another firefighter's house that happened to be off duty at the time. The truck had rolled down the street and the mirror clipped a stop sign. The sign must have come back and hit the window and cracked it. The truck came to rest in the firefighter's driveway. The truck didn't hit anything, the sign was not damaged. Chief Hadley read the driver's statement. The Driver-Robert Kizarr believed he set the parking brake but was not 100% sure.
Motion by Bothell with a second by Hadley to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with two (2) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

B. Shawn Seeley - 9/26/12
Mr. Seeley was not present. Chief Hadley said he was not sure if a report needed to be made on this incident. They were responding code 3 (lights and sirens) to 201 SE Interstate Drive which is Comfort Suites Hotel. While in the parking lot, he made a turn and the bumper went out over the curb. There was a small

bump. At the time he was not sure if he hit the curb or a decorative landscaping rock that was in the grass. After arriving back at the station, he examined the truck and found a scratch on the underneath side of the bumper. There is no proof that this scratch was not already there before this incident.

Motion by Bothell with a second by Hadley to rule this as an Unsubstantiated Incident. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

C. Shawn Adkinson – 9/17/12

Mr. Adkinson was not present. Pictures were taken of the damage but were not provided. The pictures need to be provided at the next meeting.

Motion by Hadley with a second by Bothell to table this accident.

D. Bobby Sanders – 9/15/12

Mr. Sanders was not present. Chief Hadley said Mr. Sanders was backing Engine 4 into the bay area. He was watching his spotter in the driver side mirror and was not aware that the firefighter's cab door came open. Because he was watching the spotter he did not observe the red warning light that activates when a door is open. The open truck door hit the overhead door opening. It did not take the truck out of service but it did some damage to the paint and the door stop. Motion by Hadley with a second by Bothell to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.
