4. New Business:

A. Henry Welborn- Building Maintenance (10/16/13)

Mr. Welborn was not present. Safety Rep Leon McGahee was present.

Mr. Welborn was backing out of a parking spot and backed into a car parked in another spot. There was no damage to the city vehicle but there was a small dent in the passenger door of the other vehicle.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with three points reduced to two (2) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

B. Chance Neighbors- SWC (10/24/13)

Mr. Neighbors was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present. Mr. Neighbors was driving down an alley behind the church located at 1502 WH Jones. A tree branch on the driver's side hit the mirror and caused it to swing toward the door. The mirror bracket that keeps the mirror attached to the truck broke at the base of the mirror.

C. Terry Penrod-SWC (11/21/13)

D. Gary Bishop-Streets (12/7/13)

Mr. Bishop was not present. Safety Rep James Bearbow was present. Mr. Bearbow said Mr. Bishop was driving a snow grader and was eastbound on W. Gore Blvd. He was next to the curb. James Bearbow was following behind the grader with caution lights and his light bar on. When Mr. Bishop went past a long drive way he struck the curb with the edge of the motor grader and it pushed the rear of the grader into the other lane a little. There was a pickup truck passing from the rear at the same time and the grader struck the side of the pickup. The curb was covered in snow.

Motion by Bothell with second by Whisenhunt to rule this as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.
