2. Minutes:

A. Approval of December 4, 2018 minutes.

Motion by Wright with second by Brown to approve the minutes of December 4, 2018 meeting. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

4. New Business

A. 1) Jackie Hunter – SWC (11/2/18)

Mr. Hunter was absent. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present to represent.

On Nov 2, after dumping his load at landfill Mr. Hunter failed to put tailgate of truck down and caught bridge with open tailgate. Mr. Hunter takes full responsibility of this accident and the damages done.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points plus one (1) point due to high cost of damage for a total of four (4) points was assessed.

2.) David Rolando – SWC (10/29/18)

Mr. Rolando was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present to represent Mr. Rolando.

Mr. Rolando was servicing refuse carts in a cul de sack on Willow Tree where there is no room for trash carts. When Rolando grasped the cart, which was not placed in the correct place, according to code, it rotated violently 45 degrees which often happens. The lid hit the mailbox, knocking the mailbox down. Rolando stated they have tried different positions to solve the no room problem, but some residents will not cooperate. Mr. Rolando stated he has had this route for 15 years and this has been an ongoing problem ever since the City has gotten the carts. Mr. Rolando could have gotten out of truck and moved cart to prevent incident.

Motion by Wright with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.

3.) Montra Bradley – SWC (10/24/18)

Mr. Bradley was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present to represent.

Mr. Bradley was at 2nd & D dumping an 8 yard dumpster. Ground guide did not lock dumpster onto truck. Dumpster slipped off truck and fell to ground dumping trash everywhere. Dumpster was originally facing east, but after it fell it was facing west. Mr. Bradley stated he needed to get the dumpster back in original location so in attempting to do so; he clipped a guard pillar for a gas meter damaging battery box on truck. Minimal damage was done to guard pillar.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points minus one (1) point due to low cost of damage assessed.

4.) John Lamphier – SWC (12/10/18)

Mr. Lamphier was absent. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present to represent.

Mr. Lamphier after emptying a dumpster was pulling away, turning right and when doing so the back end of the trash truck swung wide and struck a Black Dodge Ram damaging the back bumper and break light. Torque claim has been filed.

Motion by Miller with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed.

D. 1.) William Medders – Equipment Maintenance (11/19/18)

Mr. Medders present. Safety Rep Jeff Mowry present to represent.

Medders was pushing loaded truck that needed repaired into bay with a forklift. The truck was being steered by Cintora. The trucks brakes had been caged. When pushing the truck the momentum of the truck would not stop. The truck continued to roll into tool boxes and the wall before stopping. Medders stated that they should have chained the truck to the forklift to prevent the speed of the rolling truck. Torque claims have been filed for the toolboxes that were damaged.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points plus one (1) point assessed due to high cost of damage for a total of four (4) points.

E. 1.) Eugene Cintora. – Equipment Maintenance (11/19/18)

Mr. Cintora was present. Safety Rep Jeff Mowry was present to represent.

Cintora was steering dump truck that needed repaired into bay, truck was being pushed by Medders with a forklift into bay of Equipment Maintenance. The trucks brakes had been caged. As Medders pushed the truck the truck gained momentum and did not stop, running into tool boxes and the wall before coming to a stop. Cintora stated that they should have chained the truck to the forklift to prevent the truck from rolling further than it should. Torque claims have been filed for the toolboxes that were damaged.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points plus one (1) point assessed due to high cost of damage for a total of four (4) points.

F. 1.) Sonja Jones – Parks and Rec (1/6/18)

Ms. Jones was absent. Safety Rep Jim Bonnarens was present to represent.

Sonja was driving East on Meers Porter Hill Rd when a dog ran out in front of her. Sonja swerved to miss dog and hit guard rail damaging passenger mirror scraping the side of truck.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.
