2. Minutes:

A. Approval of minutes of January 7th, 2014

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to approve the minutes of January 7th, 2014. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

4. New Business:

A. Terry Penrod-SWC (1/7/14)

Mr. Penrod was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Mr. Penrod went to re-dump a cart on 29th & Arlington. He started to back up to dump the cart and he didn't pull up enough. He backed into a poll.

Motion by Bothell with second by Wright to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with three points (3) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

B. Larry Richards- SWC (1/3/14)

Mr. Richards was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Mr. Richards was heading south on 11th passing C Ave. An SUV was down the road going north in the same lane. Mr. Richards stopped to see what the SUV was going to do. The SUV tried to go between Mr. Richards' truck and a light pole but didn't fit. The SUV driver was arrested at the scene for DUI.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this as Non-Preventable with zero (0) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

C. Chris Davis-SWC (1/3/14)

Mr. Davis was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Mr. Davis pulled up to a cart. The statement said it was located about 8 to 10 inches from the mail box. The cart went up just fine but as the cart was up in the air, the truck rolled forward some. As he was putting the cart down, it came down on the mail box.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this as a Chargeable Collision with three points reduced to two (2) points assessed. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

D. William Boydston-SWC (1/6/14)

Mr. Boydston was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

The statement said Mr. Boydston drove up to empty a cart at 2306 Rolling Hills Place and saw that the cart was too close to the mailbox. He stopped the truck in what he thought was a safe distance from the cart. He reached out with the hydraulic arm and grabbed the cart. He retracted the arm and started to raise the cart when he heard a thump. When he looked he noticed that he wasn't far enough away from the mailbox and he had hit it.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.

E. Clint Macias- SWC (1/16/14)

F. Jose Ramirez- Drainage (1/16/14)

Mr. Ramirez was not present. Safety Rep Cam Huynh was present.

Mr. Ramirez's truck was parked between a fence and round concrete pipe. The location was west of Imperial Vending Warehouse. Mr. Ramirez heard someone yell and he looked up and saw an EZ-Go cart loaded with soda and snacks coming out of the warehouse without an operator. It rolled down the embankment, across the small yard, crashed through the gate and into his truck (Unit 8511). It hit the passenger side door. According to the EZ-Go cart operator, she was loading a case of soda and dropped it on the gas pedal while the cart was on.
