2. Minutes:

A. Approval of February 13, 2018 minutes.

Motion by Brown with second by Whisenhunt to approve the minutes of February 13, 2018. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

4. New Business:

A. 1) Dominic Gudger – WD (12/8/17)

Mr. Gudger was not present. Safety Rep Bobby Finley was present.

Finley stated the incident on 12-8-17 was a job that needed to haul a trailer. Pre-checked the trailer, legs on trailer was broke on passenger side. Leg on trailer

was checked with a pin that is spring loaded. Job site was off Cache & 38<sup>th</sup>. Pin appeared to be in working condition. Backhoe was loaded on trailer. Whisenhunt stated the pin that holds the jack in place was bad as noted on the report. Whisenhunt asked Finley if he assessed the pin. Finley stated he thinks the pin was bad. Whisenhunt stated equipment failure due to pin collapse.

Motion by Finley with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.

2) Adam Delciello-Cox – SWC (12/26/17)

Mr. Delciello-Cox was present. Safety Rep Bobby Finley was also present.

Delciello-Cox stated he pulled the wrong lever on the pavement breaker. He pulled the shift lever that makes it slide instead of tilt and broke a window.

Motion by Finley with second by Wright to rule this accident as Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.

3) Richard Botts – WD (1/11/18)

Mr. Botts was present. Safety Rep Bobby Finley was also present.

Botts stated he got out of the cab and the wind caught the door blowing it backwards.

Motion by Brown with second by Finley to rule this accident as Non-Preventable Damage Incident with zero (0) point assessed.

4) Aaron Williams – WD (2/2/18)

Mr. Williams was present. Safety Rep Bobby Finley was also present.

Williams stated the pipe job was on a 30 inch main line. Dug out the main and hit a window with bucket. Load fell out of the bucket.

Motion by Miller with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Non-preventable Incident with zero (0) points assessed.

5) Aaron Williams – WD (2/12/18)

Mr. Williams was present. Safety Rep Bobby Finley was also present.

Williams stated the backhoe was filled with rocks. Right front window snapped and window broke. Backhoe was on the crane. He could not hear window break. Latch on big window snapped open.

Motion by Brown with second by Finley to rule this accident as a Non-preventable Incident with zero (0) points assessed.

B. 1) Wayne Hill – SWC (1/11/18)

Mr. Hill was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Hill suspects that the dumpster was caught by the wind and wheels were locked. Dumpster was empty and wind was blowing. 3 people were on the truck. Ricardo had stated the wheels were locked. One more person was in the back. Brandon was the operator. Brown asked Hill if he was given a directive to double check the wheels. Hill answered yes, he showed a video of wheels making skid marks to Whisenhunt and Miller. Johnson stated Legal has a video of dumpster rolling into car.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as Chargeable Damage with one (1) point assessed.

2) Brandon Lejeune – SWC (1/11/18)

Mr. Lejeune was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Lejeune stated he cannot recall if the dumpster was locked or not. Lejeune was operating the levers and backed into the dumpster. Lejeune did not see the dumpster hit the vehicle.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as Chargeable Damage with one (1) point assessed.

C. 1) Charles Simmons, Jr. – WWM (1/31/18)

Mr. Simmons was present. Safety Rep Chew Allen was also present.

Simmons stated he backed into gas track meter with backhoe.

Motion by Brown with second by Allen to rule this accident as Chargeable Collision with three (points) minus one (1) point due to no cost charge with two (2) points assessed.

D. 1) Tomas Garcia-Arroyo – WWC (2/6/18)

Mr. Garcia-Arroyo was present. Safety Rep Chew Allen was also present.

Garcia-Arroyo stated he tried to pull out rod with a chain but was told to use a bigger chain with a hook. Could not hook and secure to yank out rod because it was screwed and metal piece in the truck gave way. Followed supervisor's order.

Motion by Brown with second by Allen to rule this accident as a Non-preventable Incident with zero (0) points assessed.
