2. Minutes:

A. Approval of May 15, 2018 minutes.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to approve the minutes of May 15, 2018.

3. Old Business:

1. Adam Morrison – Parks & Rec (4/18/18) **Appeal**

Formal hearing was held before Jack Hanna, Parks & Rec Director. He disagreed with the Board's ruling.

Final ruling – Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.

4. New Business

A. 1) Tony Hansley – SWC (5/14/18)

Mr. Hansely was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Johnson stated Hansley pulled up to grab the cart which was closer than what he thought. The claw caught the top corner of the spoiler on the car. Truck was not moving. The paint was chipped. Normally you would get out and move the cart. Hubbard asked what the clearance is. Johnson answered 5 foot clearance.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point minus one (1) point due to minor damage for a total of zero (0) points assessed.

2) Scott Ringener – SWC (5/17/18) **no longer with City**

Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Johnson stated Ringener was doing a 3 point turn in an alley to back in to the dumpster. Alexander Porter was the ground guide. Ringener was watching Porter and did not see or hear truck hit the building.

Motion by Hubbard with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed.

AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

3) Alexander Porter – SWC (5/17/18)

Mr. Porter was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Porter was the ground guide for Scott Ringener. Johnson stated both Ringener and Porter were at fault. Claim has been filed.

Motion by Johnson with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with two (2) points assessed.

B. 1) Charles Simmons – WWM (5/16/18)

Mr. Simmons was present. Safety Rep Chew Allen was also present.

Simmons stated he was digging a hole by the power transformer. Rubbed insulation off of neutral line. No one lost electricity. Lines were marked, bumped

into them before they were found. Allen stated safety procedure is to have line rewrapped.

Motion by Allen with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Damage Incident with zero (0) points assessed.

C. 1) Dale Watts – Streets (5/14/18)

Mr. Watts was present. Safety Rep James Bearbow was also presents.

Watts stated he was crossing a bridge. There was a truck coming northbound. The truck crossed the center line and both vehicles hit mirrors.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.

D. 1) Mark Dorrell – SSC (5/30/18)

Mr. Dorrell was present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was also present.

Dorrell stated he got pulled over. They were delivering cones couple of blocks down the road. Wright asked if he received class/training about wearing seatbelts. Dorrell answered yes and he will wear it for now on. Three people were in the truck. Tray was the driver; Dorrell was the passenger and a temp employee in the middle.

Motion by Hubbard with second by Brown to rule this incident as a Driving Violation with one (1) point assessed.

2) Travonti Osbey – SSC (5/30/18)

Mr. Osbey was present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was also present.

Osbey stated he was not wearing his seatbelt. Several times he has heard in safety meetings to wear seatbelts. He will make sure he is wearing his seatbelt.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this incident as a Driving Violation with one (1) point assessed.

3) Cory Wardell – SSC (5/30/18)

Mr. Wardell was not present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was present.

Hubbard stated Wardell was operating a bull dozer to level out the ground. Manhole was buried under ground, not visible. Manhole cover was pushed but no damage.

Motion by Hubbard with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.
