2. Minutes:

A. Approval of minutes of June 21, 2016

Motion by Brown with second by Bothell to approve the minutes of June 21, 2016. AYES: All NAYS: None Motion carried.

3. Old Business:

A. Peter Young- SWC (5/5/16) **Appeal**

Mr. Young was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was also present.

Young said he saw a white pickup parked by two trash carts. He said he pulled out in of 11th Street to hook up carts to dump them. Young said a man called an hour later and said he hit his truck. He said he didn't think he hit the truck. Whisenhunt asked who took the pictures. Johnson said Jensen did. Whisenhunt asked what was damaged on the truck. Young said wheels of cart hit truck and caused marks. Young said you can't make these marks bringing the cart up and down. Brown said she thought the arm of the garbage truck did this. Johnson said no the truck didn't move and the wheels of the cart would have made the marks. Whisenhunt said this would have broken the plastic wheels on the cart coming down. Bothell asked if the carts were two feet behind the truck. Young said yes. Bothell said the policy says five feet and the carts should have been tagged and you move on.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to uphold the board's initial ruling as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point plus one (1) point due to cost of damages with a total of two (2) points assessed.

B. Jonathan Hull - SWC (5/19/16) Appeal

Mr. Hull was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was also present.

Hull said he was driving west on Drakestone and the road was very rough and the truck bounced. He said when the truck bounced up he couldn't hit the brake because his foot got stuck. He also said he couldn't steer and he went into the grass. Hull said he kept going because he would have sunk into the grass because it was wet. Wright said the first point of contact was the curb and then you went into the grass. Hull said yes. Johnson said Hull and other employees repaired the ruts. Bothell asked what the speed limit was. Hull said 25 mph. Bothell asked what speed he was going and Hull said about 20 mph.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to uphold the board's initial ruling as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed.

4. New Business:

A. Jonathan Hull- SWC (7/11/16)

Mr. Hull was present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was also present.

Hull said he was headed east and going to turn into a cul-de-sac when a car went to pass him and he and got hooked on their bumper. Whisenhunt asked if he had his blinker on. Hull said yes.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Incident with zero (0) points assessed.

B. Danny Nunley –Landfill (5/31/16)

Mr. Nunley was not present. Safety Rep Michael McCollum was present.

McCollum said Nunley was taking a load of dirt up the slope at the landfill and couldn't reach the top. He said while Nunley was backing down with bed raised he flipped it.

Motion by Bothell with second by Whisenhunt to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points minus one (1) point due to low cost of damages with a total of two (2) points assessed.

C. Dillan Pinson –SSC (7/13/16)

***Mr. Pinson no longer works for the City.** Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was present.

Hubbard said that Pinson was following a six wheeler driven by a City employee and when he stopped Pinson rear-ended him. Hubbard said that Pinson stated that he put his foot on the brake and it wouldn't go down. Whisenhunt said he looked at the brakes and there was nothing wrong with the brakes.

Motion by Bothell with second by Hubbard to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points plus one (1) point due to cost of damages with a total of four (4) points assessed.

D. Nickolas Brown –SSC (6/28/16)

Mr. Brown was present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was also present.

Nickolas said he was backing a wench off of a trailer when it broke over and came back three feet and slid down the ramp sideways. He said when it hit the road, it stopped sliding but the top side of it kept moving and slowly rolled over onto its top. Hubbard said this a very heavy piece of equipment and the tracks go down at a slant and you can't prevent it from going.

Motion by Bothell with second by Hubbard to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Damage Incident with zero (0) points assessed.

E. Patricia Moody –Streets (7/7/16)

Ms. Moody was present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was present.

Moody said she was sweeping a cul-de-sac and there were lots of rocks due to flooding so she went over it five times. She said she went up in driveway to get the rock and then clipped a mailbox which was very close to the curb. Whisenhunt asked if it was normal to go up in a driveway. Moody said no but there was a lot of rock in the driveway. She also said she just tapped the mailbox and it went down.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points minus one (1) point due to low cost of damages with a total of two (2) points assessed.

F. Thomas Blackstar,Jr. – Lakes (6/21/16)

Mr. Blackstar was not present. Safety Rep Jim Bonnarens was present.

Bonnarens said that Blackstar was parked at the day use parking lot. He said that there are wooden posts there to keep people from driving in that area. Bonnarens said the Blackstar was watching the garbage truck and went to move out of the way and he backed up into one of the posts and bent the bumper of his City truck.

Motion by Brown with second by Bothell to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points minus one (1) point due to low cost of damages with a total of two (2) points assessed.

G. Troy Redmond – Revenue Svc (7/5/16)

Mr. Redmond was not present. Safety Rep at -large Travis Estep was present.

Wright read the report and Redmond stated that he just got done with turning off one of the meters and got into his truck. In the report, he stated that he proceeded to back out of the parking spot and looked back and didn't see any cars. When he backed up, he hit a POV. Redmond stated in his report that there was no damage to the City vehicle but damaged the POV.

Motion by Brown with second by Bothell to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points plus one (1) point due to cost of damages with a total of four (4) points assessed.

H. Justin Lewis – SWC (5/31/16)

Mr. Lewis was not present. Safety Rep Marlon Johnson was present.

Johnson said Lewis was dumping a cart when some trash bags fell out. He said the cart wasn't where it needed to be which was 5 feet from mailbox. Johnson said Lewis was trying to provide good customer service by emptying the cart. He said that when Lewis brought cart down, it came down on the mailbox.

Motion by Bothell with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.
