4. New Business

A. 1) Danny Nunley – SWD (7/21/18)

Mr. Nunley was absent. Justin Pitts present to represent for Mike McCollum.

Nunley was pushing trash when heard something hit door glass and glass started to shatter. Nunley got out of equipment and looked for an object that may have hit glass to make it break, he could not find anything lying around that would have hit window.
