2. Minutes:

A. Approval of September 4, 2018 minutes.

4. New Business

A. 1) Dusty Wilkey – WD (8/29/18)

Mr. Wilkey was absent. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard was present to represent.

On 8/29/18 Dusty had parked Service Truck #7801 facing south on the southbound shoulder of SW Sheridan Rd. Dusty had signs out and directional on. While working a black pickup struck Service Truck #7801. Dusty and other workers did not witness the incident, but noticed the damage to work bed and the driver's exterior mirror was pushed forward from its original location when returning to vehicle for supplies. Black truck did not stop and was not found.

Motion by Miller with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.

B. 1) Gregory McClain – WD (9/8/18)

Mr. McClain was present. Bobby Finley present to represent Mr. McClain.

Gregory was going to dump spoil and get rock in Dump Truck #7826 at 12:30am the morning of 9/8/18. While pulling forward he hit a 3" pump that had been pumping water from location where they working. Gregory claimed he walked around the opposite side of truck and did not do his walk around inspection before driving away. Gregory had helped put pump in that location. Ricky and Dusty were closing valves at time of incident. After running over pump, Gregory notified Ricky Botts that he had hit the pump. Estimate of new pump is \$1200.00.

Motion by Hubbard with second by Brown to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed.

AYES: All NAYS: Bobby Finley voted no. He feels accident should be ruled as Preventable Collision due to long hours that had been worked. Motion carried.

2) Bernard Nauman – Inspection Services (9/19/18)

Mr. Nauman was present. Safety Rep Britt Hubbard present to represent.

Mr. Nauman stated he was at the intersection of 8th and B, had stopped and looked both ways twice, pulled out into intersection and was hit by an oncoming car that had the right of way. Mr. Nauman made sure everyone was OK and waited for police to fill out report. Estimate of damage to City vehicle is \$1250.00. Candy stated there has been a torque claim filed and damages would be over \$3000.00 for citizen's vehicle.

Motion by Brown with second by Wright to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed, plus one(1) due to amount of damage.
