4. New Business

A. 1) Dominic Gudger – WD (9/24/18)

Mr. Gudger was absent. Safety Rep Ricky Botts and Britt Hubbard were present to represent.

On 9/24/18 Dominic was back filling hole after water main break repair. Road was muddy and slick, backhoe slid into pipe sticking out of spoil pile breaking window in backhoe.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Non-Preventable Collision with zero (0) points assessed.

2.) Galen Major – WD (10/17/18)

Mr. Major was present. Safety Rep Ricky Botts present to represent Mr. Major.

Galen stated he was on backhoe #7812 cleaning up after a water main break. Galen was taking backhoe back to city yard when he backed into a brick mailbox at 7909 NW Folkstone Way. Galen was trying to turn around in a tight spot, misjudged distance to mailbox and struck with bucket on backhoe, damaging mailbox. Whisenhunt stated there were other employees at the location that could have been a spotter to avoid accident. Estimated damage \$2,000.00.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Collision with three (3) points assessed.

B. 1.) Juan Castaneda – Streets (9/5/18)

Mr. Castaneda was absent. Safety Rep James Bearbow absent. Rusty Whisenhunt present to represent.

Juan stated he was driving down Lee Blvd near 45th to put portable stop signs out when sign blade flew out of back of truck and struck car behind him. Juan stated he was going less than 45mph and sign was not secured. According to pictures damage looks to be approximately \$1500.00.

Motion by Brown with second by Miller to rule this accident as a Chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.

C. 1.) Colt Darnell – SSC (10/24/18)

Colt stated he was backing his truck into city yard to park. Seen truck in driver side mirror, thought it was last truck in line. Colt was trying to park close to the last truck in line when he struck the parked truck. Colt did not look in his passenger side mirror or he would have seen the parked truck he struck. There was damage to grill and cooler of truck. There was \$6,100.00 in damage.
