2. Minutes:

A. Consider Neighborhood Services Accident:

1. James Julian (10/11/21)

James Julian and Neighborhood Services Supervisor Corey Bowen were both present

Julian explained he was on Williams taking pictures of some violations when an individual came up behind the city vehicle accusing him of taking pictures of his house and then started throwing beer cans at the vehicle and that is when he shattered the back window. Julian called the police and turned the car around to face the suspect and waited for the police to arrive.

C. Consider Solid Waste Collection

1. Lindsay Robert (10/04/2021)

Lindsay Robert was not present; Supervisor David Johnson was present in his absence.

Johnson explained that Lindsay had two spotters guiding him when he struck the fence. They should have told him the gate had closed some.

Morris asked if there was any damage to the fence

DJ reported the only damage was just the bar popped off.

Motion made by Miller with a second by Brown to rule this as a Non-Preventable Collision with 0 points assessed.

D. Consider Sewer Rehab Accident:

1. Louis Hertzog (10/21/21)

Hertzog explained he was excavating down the city sewer main behind 6th and did not allow for the swing radius and hit the corner of the carport.

Motion made by Brown with a second by Morris to rule this as a chargeable Damage Incident with one (1) point assessed.

E. Consider Sewer Rehab Accident:

1. David Wiedeman (10/18/21)

David Wiedeman was not present; Carl Gray was present

Gray explained that Wiedeman was operating trackhoe at Columbia & Dearborn. There was also a private sewer line, the locator did not mark this one, David came across the service line. He did not know it was interchangeable.

Motion made by Brown with a second by Wiedeman to rule this as a Non-Preventable Damage Incident Zero (0) points assessed.

F. Consider WWM Accident:

1. Simmons III, David (10/28/21)

Simmons was present with safety rep Allen Chew
Morris asked Simmons what kind of truck he was operating
Simmons replied it was a Vac Truck and was trying to turn down a "Tee" alley and ran over an old railroad tie & a hidden tree trunk and that was when he damaged the metal steps.

Morris asked about damage estimate

Miller estimated it no more than couple hundred.

Motion made by Miller with a second by Morris to rule this as a chargeable collision with three points assessed minus one for minimal damage for a total of Two (2) points assessed.

G. Consider Wastewater Collection Accident: **TABLED**

1. Gabriel Goodson (10/31/21)

Goodson was not present; safety rep Allen Chew was present.

An estimate was not taken to Equip maintenance and was not available for this accident. Chew recommended tabling this item until next meeting when a estimate can be presented to the committee.
