4. Consider making a recommendation to council to install traffic control measures on NW 35th Street.

#### Business Items

1. Review and consider potential ordinance changes regarding approval authorities for traffic control measures, allowing for the streamlined approval of traffic control requests while eliminating unnecessary process steps, and providing direction as desired.

2. Consider modifying city code regarding "Limited Access" roadways to include recommendations to the fee schedule, discuss and direct staff as appropriate.
3. Make a recommendation to City Council for implementation of a Permissive Left Turn Program, including approval of the first 10 intersections for inclusion.
4. Make a recommendation to City Council to add two streets to the "105 in '25" Mill and Overlay Program, approve a total of 107 streets, and authorize bidding.
